### Joshua Safran



Joshua Safran is an advocate for domestic violence awareness, author and attorney. His seven year legal odyssey to free a battered woman from prison was featured in the award-winning documentary *Crime After Crime*. His film

premiered at the 2011 Sundance Film Festival and on the Oprah Winfrey Network Documentary Film Club. He is a nationally recognized champion of women's rights and a zealous advocate for survivors of domestic violence and the wrongfully imprisoned.

In his new memoir, *FREE SPIRIT: Growing Up On The Road and Off The Grid*, Safran tells the story of his remarkable childhood on the dark side of the Age of Aquarius, and surviving and overcoming his violent alcoholic stepfather. The experience growing up motivated him to become an advocate for victims of domestic violence.

He has received numerous awards for his advocacy work, and his essays have been published in *Salon* and *Huffington Post*.
